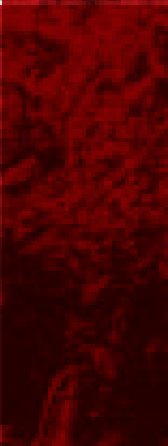
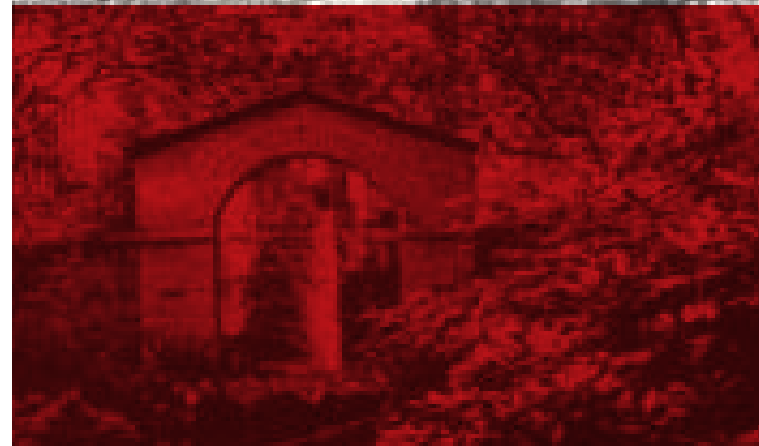
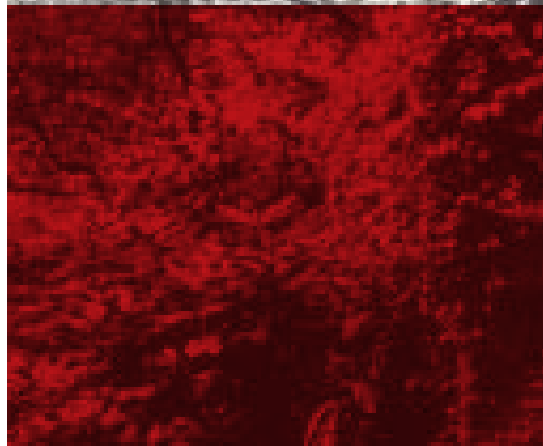

## ➤ PLACEMENT TEST

### **PLACEMENT TEST**

New students who are not complete beginners are required to take a free placement test. The test consists of two parts:

#### **WRITTEN:**

A multiple choice section, followed by a short writing sample

#### **ORAL:**

A brief conversation with a teacher

The test is offered between 9am and 6pm, Monday through Thursday; and between 9am and 3pm on Fridays. No appointment is necessary.

<b>BEGINNER</b>	

**A1** At this level students can understand and use familiar expressions, as well as basic phrases used in everyday situations. They can introduce themselves and others, and can ask or respond to personal questions, such as where they live and who they know. They can interact in a simple manner, provided the other person speaks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.

**A2** At this level students can understand full sentences and frequently used expressions related to the most immediately relevant concerns (e.g. basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment). They can communicate information pertaining to simple and routine tasks, and can describe their background, immediate environment and current situation in simple terms.

<b>INTERMEDIATE</b>

**B1** At this level students can understand descriptions of familiar situations that arise regularly at work, school or leisure time. They can deal with any issues or concerns that come up while traveling in an area where the language is spoken; are able to produce simple, connected sentences on topics which are familiar to them or of personal interest; and they can describe experiences, events, hopes, and ambitions, or briefly give reasons for opinions and plans.

<b>ADVANCED</b>

**B2** At this level students can understand main ideas in a complex text, on both the concrete and the abstract level. They can interact fluently and spontaneously with native speakers, without strain for either party; they are able to write clear, detailed essays on a wide range of subjects; and they can explain a viewpoint on a topical issue, detailing the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

<b>SUPERIOR</b>

**C1** At this level students can understand a wide range of demanding and longer texts, recognizing nuance and subtext. They can express themselves fluently and spontaneously without obvious searching for expressions; they can use language flexibly and effectively for social, academic, and professional purposes, and can produce clear, well structured, detailed essays on complex subjects, showing controlled use of organizational patterns, connectors, and cohesive devices.
